One of the most important things you can do to ensure your child has a bright future is to make sure he or she goes to school every day, and arrive on time. It sounds simple, but it's true. The correlation between school attendance and your child's achievement levels is well The more time kids established. spend at school the more likely they are to experience school success. Our target for attendance is 95% this year. As you can see we did not reach that target last year.

Australian kids only spend 15% of their total time in school so we need to maximise every day to get full value. On average many children miss between 12 and 15 days per year, this adds up to a year's lost schooling over the school life of a child. This is alarming, and puts our kids at a distinct disadvantage
